The **Pennsylvania Asphalt Pavement Association (PAPA) Gary L. Hoffman Scholarship** is intended to assist college or technical school students, etc., who are pursuing a post-secondary education related to the asphalt industry. Applicants must be enrolled in a post-secondary educational program at the time of the award.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Applicants must:

- Be a U.S. citizen.
- Be enrolled in one of the following:
 - Technical School.
 - Community College.
 - Four-year College or University.

Preference Given To:

- Pennsylvania residents.
- Students interested in or pursuing careers in the asphalt industry.
- Students affiliated with a PAPA member.

SELECTION PROCESS

The PAPA Scholarship Committee reviews completed applications and selects recipients based on:

- Application quality and completeness.
- Responses to application questions.
- Alignment with scholarship goals.

All applicants will be notified of the Committee's decision following the review process.

SCHOLARSHIP AMOUNT

- Awards of up to \$5,000 annually.
- Future-named endowment scholarships may be added, please contact the PAPA Executive Director or call 717-657-1881.

FUNDING

The Member Advisory Committee and Scholarship Subcommittee will raise scholarship funds from various activities. PAPA Members are encouraged to consider making yearly individual donations, corporate donations, or add a donation when registering for a PAPA Event.

ADMINISTRATION

The program is administered by the PAPA Executive Director through the NAPA Research and Education Foundation Scholarship Program, a 501(c)(3) organization.

AWARD PRESENTATION

Scholarships are awarded annually at the PAPA Annual Conference held in January at The Hershey Hotel in Hershey, Pennsylvania. Award recipients are welcome to attend the conference.
